The three foreign countries, however, have discarded pay and allowances structures similar to those of the U.S. system in favor of a taxable salary system. In Australia and the United Kingdom, the taxable salary system also includes an X factor paid to servicemen to compensate for the disadvantages and rigors of military life.
